Discussion of Attorney Recommendations of Upcoming Event:

Forbes contacted the Township attorney regarding the Harry Fall estate. The Township paid \$11,969.65 to Smith-Bovill for attorney fees. The Township attorney suggested that the Township Board could have a special meeting to offer a one-time deal lowering the fees or offer a temporary release of the lien if there was a pending sale with the lien to be paid off from the proceeds of the sale. Forbes stated the fees had to do with violations to the Subdivision Control Act.

Recess at 1:17pm.

Meeting called to order at 1:20pm.

Russ Fall made some comments regarding the property, stating the Township has not contacted the people associated with the issue and the people living on the road. He mentioned the previous Boards under Supervisors Larry Peslock and Ron Hubbard had issues with services like garbage pickup not being allowed on the road by Harry Fall and that the drive was to become a public road.

Motion by Forbes, seconded by Tester to make an offer at the next meeting to reduce the lien to \$7,000 if paid within 45 to 60 days or if they have a buyer for the property have the attorney draft a temporary release of lien on the property with full and immediate payment of the lien out of the proceeds of the sale.

Clinesmith requested a roll call vote.

Vote 4-1, MOTION CARRIED.

Public Comment:

Don Clinesmith mentioned that the Township's phone system is not working; he is having trouble calling the Township Hall.

John Stack asked why we aren't telling the tech support about this. No one is calling about the problem!

Russ Fall mentioned about the wood chips in the park: he put a sign "no more woodchips" in the park, but they are still being dumped in the park. They are blocking off the entrances to the park.

Bob Forbes stated that the power companies were dropping them off in the park. He stated he would call Proline to tell them to stop dumping them.

John Stack would like to get rid of the old heavy wooden tables and get new ones.

Motion by Stack, seconded by Tester to replace the old wooden tables with up to 10 new plastic ones.

Vote 5-0, MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Forbes, seconded by Stack to sell the old wooden tables for \$10 each.

Motion by Tester, seconded by Gray to adjourn.
